Day Visitor Pass Information

Adults (<i>per person</i>)	\$10.00 midweek \$15.00 weekends & holidays
Children under 12 (<i>per person</i>)	\$8.00 midweek \$11.00 weekends & holidays
Families (<i>two adults & two children under 12</i>)	\$28.00 midweek \$41.00 weekends & holidays

Day visitors are not permitted to enter the Mountain House or use the lake and its facilities.

Grounds close one hour prior to sunset. The Picnic Lodge offers food, gifts and film and is open 10am-5pm daily in the summer season and on weekends and holidays in the spring and fall.

Directions from NYS Thruway exit 18: After tollbooth, turn left onto Route 299 West. Travel through the village of New Paltz, cross over the Wallkill River bridge, and make your first right onto Springtown Road. Take your next left onto Mountain Rest Road and continue up to the top where you will see the Gatehouse on your left.

Visitor Center: Open Tuesday-Sunday and holiday Mondays 9am-5pm (closed Thanksgiving Day, Christmas Day, New Years Day)

Land: Open every day of the year, sunrise to sunset

Fees: Membership—\$50 basic individual
Non-member day fee (*per person*)—\$8 per day to hike, \$10 per day to bike and/or rock climb
Children under 12- free

The largest member and visitor supported nature preserve in New York State, the Mohonk Preserve protects over 6,500 acres of the northern Shawangunk Ridge.

Directions from NYS Thruway exit 18: After tollbooth, turn left onto Route 299 West. Travel through the village of New Paltz, cross over the Wallkill River bridge, and continue to the end of Route 299 where it meets Route 44/55. Turn right and travel 1/4 mile to the Preserve entrance on your right.

Minnewaska State Park Preserve

Hours: Opens daily at 9am

Fees: Summer \$7/car, after Labor Day \$6/car

Situated on the Shawangunk Mountain ridge which rises more than 2,000 feet above sea level, bicycling, canoeing, picnicing, hiking, horseback riding, pets on leash, cross country skiing, swimming.

Directions from NYS Thruway exit 18: After tollbooth, turn left onto Route 299 West. Travel through the village of New Paltz, cross over the Wallkill River bridge, and continue to the end of Route 299 where it meets Route 44/55. Turn right and continue for five minutes to park entrance on your left.

Wallkill Valley Rail Trail

Trail closes at dusk, leashed dogs allowed, motorized vehicles prohibited.

12.2 miles of unpaved linear park from Gardiner to New Paltz to Rosendale perfect for walking, jogging, biking, cross-country skiing and horseback riding. Officially opened in October 1993 as the 17th rail trail in New York State.

Directions from NYS Thruway exit 18: After tollbooth, turn left onto Route 299 West. Rail trail crosses over Route 299 just before the Wallkill River bridge. Also access off of Plains Road, Broadhead Avenue.
